Services are provided at low cost, usually around \$13. No one is ever turned away from the clinic because they can't afford health care.

- Sports, school, employment and annual physical exams
- Care for illness & injuries
- Screening for STI's and HIV
- Help coping with stress

- Dental referrals
- Referral of female partners for health services
- Single Stop USA assessments and referrals for Food Stamps, health insurance, GED, employment, & legal services
- All are welcome, regardless of race, ethnicity, income, or sexual orientation

- **Register** at the front desk.
- Complete some paperwork about your health history. Health education information will be in the waiting room about important health topics.
- You will be called by a doctor, health educator, social worker, or a medical assistant.
- We will **check** your blood pressure, height, weight, vision, and ask if you want an HIV test.
- You will stop at the front desk so you can make your next appointment.
